



Non - Member Guest Skating Policy

Approved by the Board (September 17, 2008)

Definition:

Non-Member: anyone who has paid the Skate Canada fee and is not enrolled in any StarSkate program with the Fergus Skating Club.

The Fergus Skating Club is happy to accept guest skating of non-members under the following conditions:

- 1) The maximum a non-member skater can guest skate from August to April is 10 times.
- 2) The cost for non-member guest skating is \$15.00 per hour . Fee is subject to change upon approval of the Board, at which time the policy will be updated.
- 3) No skater may skate without being a member in good standing of Skate Canada for the appropriate skating year (due September 1st, to their home club).
- 4) The guest skating fees are payable in advance of stepping on the ice, and arrangements must be made with the registrar at least 48 hours in advance of any guest skating.
- 5) Non-member guest skating only applies to private ice time. Club provided programs are not permitted.
- 6) Anyone under the age of 18 must have a certified coach / parent / or guardian in attendance – off-ice - at all times.
- 7) Skating etiquette policy must be adhered to.
- 8) Programs by discipline schedules must be observed and adhered to.
- 9) All other applicable policies of the Fergus Skating Club must be observed and followed.
- 10) Any skater who is not registered as an FSC member and is skating at an FSC hosted test day, will be charged a fee of \$20.00 per test to cover test day associated costs, including Skate Canada Fees. This fee is subject to change upon Board approval, at which time the policy will be updated.
- 11) The Fergus Skating Club's year-end Showtime is intended to showcase the achievements of members of the FSC enrolled in a program session, therefore only members participating in programs at the FSC will participate in Showtime.
- 12) The non-member guest skating policy is in effect from October 1 until the beginning of April the following year.
