Financial Information

- * Program changes occurring after the printing of this brochure will be posted on the FSC bulletin board and in newsletters.
- * All fees are in Canadian funds. Please make cheques payable to the Fergus Skating Club. Cheques must include your telephone number and be submitted with the application form. Please include the name of your skater and program on the cheque.
- * Deposits will be cashed upon receipt and/or postdate on cheque. NSF cheques will be charged a \$25.00 administrative fee.
- * The Skate Canada fee of \$31.00 is due once a year (September 1, 2009 - August 31, 2010). FSC members must submit the fee with this application form, unless paid with Fall Program registration.
- * For Insurance and Liability reasons, no skater can be allowed on the ice to participate in any Fergus SC program without being a registered member of Skate Canada. To allow the club sufficient time to register the skater, **enrollment must be completed a minimum of one week prior to commencing any program.** Late registration will cause a delay in your skater starting their program.
- * Cancellation of registration after commencement of any program or N.S.F. cheques will result in a \$25.00 administration charge. The Skate Canada Fee will not be refunded. Refunds for the Canskate program will be pro-rated up to 4 weeks into the session. Refunds for the Kidskate program will be pro-rated up to 6 weeks into the Oct.-March session, and up to 3 weeks into the Oct.-Dec. or Jan.-March session. After that time there will be no refunds.
- * When enrolling 3 children from one family in the "Learn to Skate" programs, we will reduce the registration fee for the third child by 10%.

Learn to Skate Program Description

KIDSKATE PROGRAM

Program Requirement: Skaters must have reached their 3rd birthday prior to beginning of program. This program is suitable for 4 and 5 year old children.

- Program is professionally developed and centers on the introduction to skating and the ice using a fun, animated approach versus a badge system (as in Canskate).
- Skaters work in small groups based on their skating skills and learn how to skate forward, backwards, turn, stop, spin and jump.
- The Skate Canada certified Professional coaches and their Coaching Assistants work to teach skaters using entertaining and fun lessons - suitable for this age's attention span. CSA approved Helmet Mandatory.
- To move from Kidskate to Canskate during the year is a flat fee of \$25.00.
- We are excited to offer 45 minute Kidskate Sessions for the 09/10 season!!!

CANSKATE PROGRAM

Program Requirement: program is designed for skaters who are a minimum of 5 yrs of age as of October 1st, 2009 through to older children and teenagers.

- Program is a professionally developed and nationally tested learn-to-skate program that provides a solid foundation for all skating sports: hockey, ringette, figure and synchronized skating, speed skating, and of course - recreational skating.
- Skaters move through different stations which focus on the grouped skating skills of Go Forward, Go Backward, Stop, Turn, Spin and Jump.
- All instruction is provided by Skate Canada certified Professional coaches and their Coaching Assistants.
- Skaters are evaluated regularly and progress through the six stages at their own pace.
- CSA approved Helmet mandatory to stage 4.
